MATH CLASS INFORMATION

MATH CLASS:

We will be using the Ready Classroom Mathematics program that coordinates with i-Ready.

The program, i-Ready, is an online portion of our math. Students are required to complete 45 minutes each week. I allow time in class for this to be completed, but if your child is absent or does not complete it in class, they will need to complete their time at home. Please log on to stay on track. i-Ready time is part of their grade. Students may also log on for extra practice.

HOMEWORK:

Most days we will complete a lesson from the math textbook. Students will be given time in class to complete their homework assignments. If it is not completed in class, they are expected to finish it at home and turn in their completed homework the following day.

If students would like to fix their grade, they can make corrections for half a point each. Students will be given time in class to complete their homework, though if not completed, it will be taken home to finish.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM:

All assignments will be posted on Google Classroom. Students will use this platform to access their assignments in class. This also allows students to access their assignments to complete any missing work if they are sick, on vacation or absent for other reasons.
